### From Phoenix

From Phoenix, travel north on Interstate 17 for 100 miles to Exit 298. Follow Highway 179 North to Sedona. Continue through the Village of Oak Creek 15 miles to the intersection of Highway 179 and Highway 89A. Turn left and proceed 3 miles through West Sedona to Dry Creek Road. Turn right and proceed North for 5 miles. Follow the signs to The Enchantment. Estimated travel time- 2 hours.

### From Flagstaff

Travel south on Highway 89A towards Sedona for approximately 35 miles. Turn right onto Dry Creek Road and proceed North for 5 miles. Follow the signs to The Enchantment. Estimated travel time- 40 minutes

### From Las Vegas

Travel south on Interstate 515 towards Kingman, Arizona. Exit east on Interstate 40 towards Flagstaff. Exit Interstate 17 south at Flagstaff towards Phoenix. Travel 35 miles south to exit 298 and follow Highway 179 North towards Sedona. Continue through the Village of Oak Creek 15 miles to the intersection of Highway 179 and Highway 89A. Turn left and proceed 3 miles through West Sedona to Dry Creek Road. Turn right and proceed North for 5 miles. Follow the signs to The Enchantment. Estimated travel time- 5 hours.

### By Air

Fly into Phoenix Sky Harbor Airport and rent a car or transfer to an America West shuttle flight landing in Flagstaff. Follow the auto directions provided above.
